

Secondary Containment – J&M Plating

Operations: J&M Plating is a single-source, world-class leader in the plating and finishing industry with two plants in the Rockford, Illinois area. They primarily serve the fastener industry with fully automated, computer-controlled zinc and phosphate barrel plating and finishing services.



Problem: J&M Plating had a 48' x 20' x 4' high oil storage tank at their production facilities. Due to the EPA's regulations governing containment of hazardous materials, the company was in need of a secondary containment solution.

Solution: The secondary containment bin was sprayed with Durabond™ at 1/4" on the floor and 1/8" on the walls. Rhino Linings' meet the EPA's secondary containment regulations set forth by SPCC Title 40, Part 112 and CAFO Title 40, Part 412.

Results: J&M has had a zero failure rate on their secondary containment.
